Julien Louis Tavernier was born on August 22, 1879 in Paris and is the son of Alexandre Marie Tavernier, a fabric manufacturer, and Blanche Hornorine Hutinet. He was a student of Léon Bonnat, and exhibited at the Salon from 1908, then became a member of the Society of French Artists. In 1909, he received a medal of honor, a silver medal in 1925 accompanied by the
