Half-moon front sight. Cancelled five-chamber cylinder, marked 1 & L. Gold finish. Single-action operation. Closed frame, nickel-plated finish. Gold-plated spur trigger. Gold-finish hammer, bolt ears and spring. Rosewood stock plates. This model has been finished in nickel and varnish, with remnants of gilding.
