Beautiful bronze statue of a dog, likely a spaniel, bringing game back to its master. Everything in its attitude denotes pride: the piercing gaze that we guess is fixed on that of the master, the raised head and the conquering nose above the duck offered in its mouth. In addition to the attitude of pride, we note the calm of the posture. The dog is sitting with its tail tucked along its body as if in submissive expectation and the quest for a rewarding caress. We are in the presence of very careful work. We noticed the gaze but we discover well-drawn, well-established ears on which the fur is precisely drawn as on the whole body. The game is rich in details and the terrace is not neglected either. A trunk starts to allow the dog to lean on it. 15 cm high and 15 cm long, this small unsigned patinated bronze statue will
