From a 14th-century parish church in the village of Week St Mary, between Cornwall and Devon, England, it is believed that this piece originated from an earlier building and was incorporated into the new church in the 14th century. A truly stunning and intriguing piece, both visually and historically, of impressive size. Presented on a contemporary metal stand.
