good condition, slight wear from use, it has a decoration of arabesques and flowers for the field and a series of many cypresses for the border. This beautiful Persian carpet takes up the criteria of ancient Persian decorations, knotted with great finesse. From the second part of the 19th century, we can hardly imagine the immense work to knot such a marvel. The quality of these Persian pieces is not to be demonstrated, the work is fine, precise and durable. The materials used are of first quality: This carpet is clean, the wool is knotted admirably and finely tight as these carpets always are. It reveals to us nuances full of contrasts, many colors, blue, pink, red, green, apricot, black and ivory. # The cypresses are not there by chance, we see the Mainu Spentas cypress, linked to the Zoroastrian religion. It is, it is believed, associated with the light of the God Ormuzd and Zoroaster, at his death he is transported to the highest mountain and there, he is transformed. Other legends, they say the tallest cypress in the world, the cypress of paradise, planted by Zoroaster and Kashmar (Torchiz). The nuances underline this learned floral design in the great tradition of Persian art that is also found in Mughal art, inspired by the miniatures of the school of Tabriz, then capital of the Persian Empire. # Carpet knotted under the Kadjars dynasty or Kadjars (Qajar, Qadjar, Qajar, Persian: قاجار) Turkmen dynasty which reigned over Iran from 1786 to 1925. ## For information: Tabriz (Azerbaijani: تبریز/ تَبْرِيز, formerly Tauris), is the capital of the province of East Azerbaijan, in the northwest of Iran (Iranian Azerbaijan). Tabriz is located on the course of the Talkheh River (also called Aji-Chai), near Lake Urmia, close to the borders of the Republic of Azerbaijan and Armenia. It is the gateway to Persia from north to west. The Tabriz have an extreme importance in the quality of Persian carpets and a very great international reputation.
