Directoire period - Consulate - 1st Empire, Hussar sabre, light cavalry with scabbard, 18th-19th century. Pommel with Leonine face with rivet button and long tail. Flat joint arc at right angle. Quillon with orillons called shuttle ending in a rolled end. Flat curved blade with 1 edge and counter-edged point. Blued and gilded blade in the 1st third, with floral motifs, trophies, sun, garlands. Blade with central groove. Fluted black horn fuse, black leather scabbard with 2 brass fittings, without chape button, dart rivet.
