Theodore Deck (1823-1891) is a French ceramist born in Guebwiller in Alsace. He even won a Silver Medal at the 1867 Universal Exhibition in Paris. At the end of his career, he became director of the Sèvres national factory. In the field at that time, Théodore Deck was among... Inspired to the point of pastiche by Egyptian, Chinese, Japanese ceramics or majolica, he developed characters, birds, flowers, ornaments of all kinds under a turquoise, green,
