Description

This bronze by Charles Paillet tenderly depicts a scene of canine maternity. Lying peacefully, a terrier-type dog watches over her puppies, who eagerly suckle. The sculpture's realism demonstrates the artist's great talent, both in the fineness of the coat and the animals' natural attitudes. The mother's expressive gaze and balanced composition convey a scene full of gentleness and life. The signature "CH. PAILLET" is visible on the base of the bronze, attesting to the work's authenticity. Charles Paillet: Charles Paillet is a French sculptor renowned for his work in animal art. He studied under sculptor Georges Gardet, a major figure in animal sculpture in France. Paillet is part of a generation of artists who have captured the beauty of the animal world with realism and
