BICORN HAT OF MUSKETEERS OF THE KING'S MILITARY HOUSE, second company "BLACK MUSKETEERS", for riding school dress, 1814 model, Restoration. 29236 Black "Flemish" felt hat; H of the front part from the curved part 18 cm, H of the front part from the bottom of the horns 26 cm, H of the rear part from the curved part 26.5 cm, H of the rear part from the bottom of the horns 34 cm, width 42 cm, depth 17 cm.Braid formed of three matte and shiny silver twists, they double around the uniform button and are held by this same button.Large module silver uniform button, model 1814: half-domed, embossed with the cross of the musketeers of the second company (diameter of the button 2.6 cm).Silver passementerie cockade with white silk center
