Curved blade with a single convex edge. Handle covered with silver sheet with geometric decoration of spikes. Wooden scabbard covered with leather and leather strap. Slight accidents and dents to the silver on the back of the handle. Weight 193grWeight without scabbard 160grLength 28cmLength without scabbard 25.5cmBlade length 13.5cm
