Magnificent fossilized mammoth tooth, on a custom stand. The mammoth was a prehistoric mammal related to the elephant, but much larger. Mammoths lived in the cold regions of Europe, Asia, and North America during the Ice Age. They had thick fur and long, curved tusks. The best-known species is the woolly mammoth. Mammoths became extinct about 4,000 years ago, probably due to climate change and human hunting.
