Description

The vase has a rounded, globular shape with a relatively narrow opening and a widened, decorated base. The raised areas are a pinkish beige with warm highlights, while the recessed parts are dark, almost black, creating a strong contrast with the relief. The relief work is characteristic of the Art Deco period. The ceramics workshop is located in a place known as Revernay. The first pieces were presented at the 1900 Universal Exhibition in Paris.
