Large bouquet of flowers and fruits painted in oil on panel 81cm x 60cm plus frame 103cm x 81cm signed lower right A.FERRARI This painting was exhibited at the Salon d'Automne in Paris in 1972 and can be seen in a photo of his studio on the right on an easel Antoine FERRARI born in 1910 in Marseille, died in 1995 He is one of the greatest Provençal painters of his generation A gestural, lively, nervous painting for a character who exuded exemplary tranquility and serenity He was a student at the Beaux-Arts in Marseille. At 17 he left for Paris and went to work in a theater set design workshop He began to exhibit in 1928 He met Ambrogiani and from 1930 he obtained a scholarship to study painting In 1937, he won the Abdel-Tif prize which allowed him to spend two years in Algeria.
