The bronze frame is later and 19th century. Voltaire, whose real name is François-Marie Arouet, born on November 21, 1694 in Paris where he died on May 30, 1778, is a French writer and philosopher, enjoying international fame during his lifetime and considered today as an emblematic and central figure of the Enlightenment.
