trapeze", a poetic reference tying the artwork to

both the circus setting and Henri de

Toulouse-Lautrec himself.Artist Details Henri de

Toulouse-Lautrec (1864-1901) was a master of

capturing life on the fringes of society--cabarets,

dancers, and circus performers.This lithograph

was likely created in the mid-20th century as

a tribute or reproduction after Lautrec's pastel,

possibly by a French printing house or artist's

studio operating under the name le Goutteur

Courtier (no biographical records found under

this name).Frame Condition: The artwork is

elegantly presented in a dark wood frame with a

slim gold inner edge and a soft green matting.

Frame and glass are in very good condition, with

only minor signs of age-related wear that

complement the vintage aesthetic. The paper

retains its deckled edges and is beautifully
