Circa 1938-1940FranceEvening dress and bolero in black silk panne velvet painted with floral bouquets dating from the beginning of the Second World War. Sheath dress, cut on the bias and large open back neckline held by wide straps, applied with painted velvet patches. The dress is flared at the bottom accentuating the grace of the walk, On one side, a slit opening with snap buttons, allowing a less restrictive putting on. The bolero with a wide collar hugging the shoulders, is tilted at the back, thanks to wide ruffled basques. It has a neckline on the front closed by a large matching button and small short puffed sleeves. The bodice is lined with black duchess satin and unmarked. I won't hide from you that this set is rare and uncommon, it is a museum piece, possibly wearable for a very slim young
