Entirely hand-knotted with an exceptional density of 8,000 knots per square decimeter, it is made of kurk wool, renowned for its finesse and softness. This refined model features a central diamond-shaped medallion with geometric contours, set against a background adorned with traditional floral motifs. Its harmonious color palette - ruby red, midnight blue, ivory, with accents of green and black - testifies to the characteristic elegance of Sénneh rugs. In perfect condition, this highly precise rug is a rare piece, ideal for enriching a collection or enhancing a high-end decoration.
