Belgian painter Jean Coene is the son of genre and history painter Constantin Coene. He studied under his father at the Antwerp Academy and achieved success as a painter of Romantic landscapes featuring woods, rivers, lakes, and mountains. He exhibited at the Brussels Salon in the 1840s. Our painting is a fine example of the Belgian Romantic school of landscapes from the mid-19th century, with a highly decorative yet atmospheric feel. Noteworthy are the beautiful colors (particularly the beautiful blue of the lake), the fine craftsmanship (the beautifully painted
