Description

Portrait of a seated man, oil on canvas by Michel Paquet, renowned Quebec painter (1948-1990). Good condition, note a small scratch on the right side of the jacket. Signed on the back. Dimensions : 80 X 60 cm. Michel Paquet was born in Thetford Mines, Quebec in 1948. He began his career in science and psychopedagogy before training in visual arts at the Université du Québec à Trois-Rivières and later in art history at Laval University in Quebec City. He first became known as an abstract painter, later focusing on figurative art. His style is distinguished by a purification of subjects and colors. He works in acrylic, oil, gouache and pencil drawing. He died suddenly in 1990, but left behind a large body of work, many of which are now in museums.
