Ewer and its display stand in finely engraved rock crystal and enameled silver mount Work in the style of the 16th century Viennese Renaissance Attributed to Hermann Böhm The rock crystal is engraved with delicate motifs, fine scrolls and arabesques where birds and mascarons with human faces nest, bear the mark of Renaissance models. From the silver handle with its aerial outline stands the small enameled bust of a female term, which its vigilant position transforms into a figurehead. Pretty engraved decoration of floral interlacing. Display stand with 9 compartments. Height of ewer: 16.5 cm Diameter of display stand: 17 cm Restoration to the spout of the ewer.
