An important Rose Famille enamelled porcelain wine cooler. The body is decorated with flowers, notably peonies, as well as bamboo branches and various flowers. The neck of the cooler is decorated with a frieze that repeats the decoration on the body, against a background of brown enamel motifs. On either side are two shell-shaped handles. China XVIIIE Early Qianlong period (1736-1795) This wine cooler is particularly large, contrary to the models regularly seen, and could almost be used as a cache pot.
