Like many surveying instruments, it is placed on a three-pronged oak stand or on a simple stake. Sighting is done by aligning three elements: the narrow hole of the first small brass plate or pinnule, the crossed reticle of the other pinnule parallel to the previous one and a point on a staff which is placed at a certain distance. This is an application of the phenomenon of rectilinear propagation of light.
