French school of the second half of the 19th century, After Michelangelo Buonarroti, known as Michelangelo (1475-1564). Lorenzo II de Medici (1492-1519), Duke of Urbino, known as the Magnificent. Finely chiseled bronze proof with a beautiful nuanced brown patina. Intaglio signature of the founder Ferdinand Barbedienne. Period of the end of the 19th century. Height 40 cm Ferdinand Barbedienne (1810-1892), mainly known for his bronze foundry, joined forces in 1838 with the mechanic Achille Collas (1795-1859), inventor of the process of reproducing bronze and art objects.
