Created with the aim of transforming the classic glassmaking craft into an innovative art, capable of quickly becoming the main character of the Milan Triennales, the Venice Biennales and exhibitions in all European countries and the United States. A result made possible by the synergy, promoted by Venini himself, between masters, designers and architects from all over the world, with the aim of
