The cabinet consists of five modules, each with a specific function. Two modules are equipped with double sliding glass panels, ideal for displaying objects while protecting them from dust. Another module has doors, providing a closed storage space. A fourth module, also with sliding doors, provides access to adjustable shelves, allowing the storage space to be adapted as needed. Finally, the last module offers three drawers, two of which are differently compartmentalized, perfect for organizing small items. The iron handles, with a minimalist design, add a touch of
