Large and remarkable impressionist painting dating from the 1950s which represents a luminous view of the port of Marseille with in the background the silhouettes of the forts Saint-Jean and Saint-Nicolas facing each other... The work is signed by the Dutch painter Rudolph Polder (1926-2016) whose interesting biography can be read on the Wikipedia site: originally from The Hague in the Netherlands, Rudolph Polder will be recognized by critics in the 1950s, notably for the originality of his chromatism and the soft luminosity which bathes his seaside landscapes.. note that one of the paintings which illustrates the Wikipedia site and which represents "the old port of Marseille" is completely in the same palette as the work proposed here... note: the artist who adored Marseille will settle there around 1952,
