This contrast between the ornamentation of the base and the sobriety of the cup creates an attractive and harmonious visual balance. Although the ciborium bears no visible hallmarks, an acid test has been performed to ensure it is made of genuine silver, and we offer a written certification for those who desire greater assurance in their investment.
