Case, back, crown and chronograph buttons, bezel, as well as the lugs and lugs of the watch are made of solid 18-karat gold. For your information, the net weight of the gold in the case back alone is 4.52 grams! Gross weight of the watch: 39.12 grams, including the mechanism and glass. There is a significant amount of gold in all these elements. See photos for hallmarks and marks on the watch. There will be no indication of the exact weight of the gold, as we do not sell this type of item for scrap. This watch is reserved exclusively for people who will appreciate it for what it is!

Movement - Mechanical Hand-wound mechanism, very sound, with no signs of oxidation or internal moisture. Landeron caliber 13, which corresponds to a production from the 1940s. Swiss mechanical. This watch works perfectly; it has been serviced.

Dial and Hands Champagne-colored dial, with the inscription "DELWA Fab Suisse" and a cross, and an illegible initial character before DELWA. Dial, as is (pitting noted), features even Roman numerals, as well as several railway tracks, for the telemeter, the tachymeter, among others. Five hands in good condition, see photos. 30-minute chronograph minute counter.

Crown and Buttons Original crown, functional for setting the time and winding, in good condition. The chronograph buttons work very well and are very smooth.

Case, Bezel, and Caseback Shows acceptable, normal micro-scratches typically found on a pre-owned watch from the 1940s. Case in good condition, see numerous photos. The bezel is in good condition, same as for the case. Clip-on caseback in good condition.

Crystal Shows small scratches, it can be replaced with a new Plexiglas crystal, ask...

Strap New from old stock, never worn. In perfect harmony with the watch, genuine black seal, leather lining. This strap is in excellent condition; it is new and from stock from the same period as the watch,

with a gold-plated buckle. A good investment... Depending on its age, over 80 years old, this watch should not be submerged. We do not guarantee ANY watch against immersion.
