The base of the clock is decorated with a frieze reproducing the various elements described above as well as a frieze of palmettes at the base. The body of the clock is decorated with a lyre surrounded by two swans and surmounted by two cornucopias. Enamelled dial in very good condition. Original pendulum and key, wire movement.
