We find all the symbols symbolizing wealth, seduction, return from Egypt and splendor of the Empire ... with among others the palmettes, fleurons, Golden Calf surmounted by crossed horns of plenty with mascaron surmounted by a Peacock, Swans with outstretched wings, all on an amati background. The blades of the dessert knives are in stainless steel. Please note that this pzttern is still marketed by Odiot. Masterly crafted from the highest quality silver, each piece bears the Minerva 1st Standard Hallmark (.950) and the mark of
