Portrait of a man of the church, seen from three-quarter front, with tribute cartouche. Text of the cartouche: « RP Chrysostome Girardot, CD Born in Amsterdam If combined with zeal a manly eloquence had always had power over hearts, whether Chrysostome instructs, exhorts or reprimands, he will always touch his listeners. » The priest's gaze is lively, the habit is made with a certain finesse. The work is in good condition. We note the presence of several restorations visible on the back. It is presented in a pretty gilded stuccoed frame from the 19th century, in good condition (some gilding defects).
