A highly collectible pair of porcelain figurines by Helena Wolfsohn, Dresden, circa 1875. Young grape pickers stand next to vine-laden trunks, each with a grape basket. Finely hand-painted in polychrome enamels with gilt accents, these 18th-style models bear the "Augustus Rex" stamp, reflecting Wolfsohn's mastery of decorative enamel work.
