Jean Luce (1895-1964), initially a goldsmith, became a designer of refined ceramics in the 1920s, influenced by the Art Deco aesthetic. Favoring pure forms and sober geometric decorations, he collaborated in the 1930s with Villeroy & Boch Luxembourg. Through this factory, he produced pieces in fine earthenware and porcelain, combining elegance and quality industrial production.
