It features a front vise with its original wrought iron handle, still functional and full of industrial charm. The thick top bears the marks of intensive manual work, lending the piece an honest, unembellished beauty.Carefully restored, this workbench was cleaned using a gentle aerogommage process--an eco-friendly method that projects fine particles at low pressure to remove impurities without damaging the material. The wood has regained its natural tone while preserving its original
