Léopold Pierre Antoine Savine (1861-1934), known as Léopold Savine, was a French sculptor. As a student of Jean-Antoine Injalbert at the École nationale supérieure des beaux-arts, Léopold Savine made his debut in 1888 at the Salon of the French artists. He produced a large number of statuettes and female busts in the Art Nouveau style. He was awarded a bronze medal at the 1900 Paris Exposition.
