His characters were often adorned with flowers or fruit and some of his generic studies were completed whilst he travelled throughout Europe and the UK, His work is highly sought after and is held in the UK Government Art Collection. This portrait is an absolutely delightful work and is a prime example of the artist's talent for creating expressive compositions that are not only skillfully executed depictions of female figures, but also evocative scenes that invite the viewer into the world of the subject. The tonality of the composition is still very distinctive, and the artist had a remarkable ability of capturing the sitter's personality.Carroll's work depicts both the innocence and beauty of the subject while at the same time gives each figure a unique character. Given this painting is approximately 150 years old, it is in very good condition.
