But this decanter was produced in the 1910s/1920sWell marked with sand, MADE IN FRANCE by ROCHER FRERES La Côte Saint André FRANCEThe pattern is perhaps the CHABLIS model from Baccarat, without certainty.It is not signed Baccarat, because it was an order and there was no room to add the Baccarat brand, which was not systematically indicated by Baccarat, especially at that time...The decanter

does not have any trace of limescale, the photos highlight droplets following cleaning, they are no longer present. The neck mount and the cap trim are silver, not hallmarked. The cap is dry and has reduced over time, it still provides a simple stopper function, not watertight, by soaking it, it could regain more flexibility and relax ... The Rocher Frères distillery is one of the oldest French spirits houses, founded in 1705 in La Côte-Saint-André (Isère) by Barthélémy Rocher. This family business, now known as Cherry Rocher, has played a major role in the history of liqueurs in France. Barthélémy Rocher, born in 1677, learned about distillation by helping his uncle, canon in charge of the hospices of La Côte-Saint-André. Passionate about botany, he developed preparations based on macerations of fruits and plants, sweetened, which met with great success. In 1705, he founded what is considered the first distillery in France, receiving an award that year when the Dauphin of France passed through Grenoble. Over the generations, the Rocher distillery gained in renown. In the 19th century, it merged with other regional distilleries: - 1830: merger of the Neyret and Arnaud distilleries to form Neyret-Arnaud. - Later integration of the Chavin distillery, giving birth to Neyret-Chavin. - Merger of Neyret-Chavin with Cherry Rocher, thus consolidating several know-how under the same brand.
