Jean Hennau's large stained glass window is a unique piece made by a master glassmaker, with great technical mastery (stained stained glass with lead) and inspired by a masterpiece by Géricault. Size 150 x 138 cm. This stained glass window is therefore a reinterpretation of a famous work by Théodore Géricault, probably "Officier de chasseurs à cheval de la garde impériale de charge" (1812), an emblematic work of French romanticism. Technical: This is a stained glass window made of paint on glass with lead settings, fixed in an aluminum frame. The glass pieces are painted and then assembled in the old-fashioned way, which makes it a piece of craftsmanship. Size: 150 x 138 cm, it is a large dimension, which reinforces its decorative impact.
