Hans-Agne Jakobsson (1919-2009) Born in Hvalhem on the island of Gotland in 1919, Hans-Agne Jakobsson completed his apprenticeship as a carpenter before studying architecture in Gothenburg. He began his career as an industrial designer at General Motors and then became an assistant to Carl Malmsten, one of the most prominent figures in Swedish design. In 1951, he set up his own company, Hans-Agne Jakobsson AB, in Markaryd and began creating original lighting fixtures. Like many Scandinavian designers, he is strongly influenced
