Émile Bertin, painter, illustrator and theater designer active in Paris is recognized for being a contemporary of Antoine, Gemain and Sarah Bernhardt with whom he collaborated. Trained at the Beaux-Arts, he worked in particular for Parisian theaters and lyric productions, developing a style combining architectural precision and dreamlike atmospheres. testifies to the talent of this painter and decorator to create elegant and suggestive stage atmospheres.
