PAIR OF ALGERIAN SPURS (CHÂBIR)-

Wrought iron with long slanted stems, rectangular strap loops and round then slanted branches with applied silver inserts, chiseled and worked in repoussé with foliage scroll motifs. Two coral cabochons enliven the heels on each of them. ABE condition with traces of use and usage.- The spiked spurs that were used in most of the Islamic world evolved directly from examples from late Antiquity.
