There are several watercolors by BOUDIN illustrating scenes of daily life in Brittany, using the wash technique and the same chromatic range, such as "Breton interior, maternity" sold for 8,100 euros by Christie's on 04-14-21 (lot 10) or "Breton woman holding a bowl in an interior" in the collections of the Musée d'Orsay (inventory reference RF 16939).
