From 1868 he participated in the Salon de Paris andthen at the Salon Des Artistes Français, becoming a member in 1885. He received several third and second class medals. Then he also participated in the Exposition Universelle in 1889 and 1900 where he was awarded medals.In 1883, Valton was a
