Jeanne Adam Lechopié (1724-1795) Received master watchmaker by Privileges on January 10, 1758 holding shop 67 rue des Neuve des Petits Champs in Paris He will be appointed Visiting Guard of the corporation, he will provide high quality clocks, White marble clock and black marble base, on spinning feet, it is decorated with a group representing Venus and Cupid, the base decorated with a bas-relief representing the playing Cupids, the enameled dial is signed Lechopié in Paris, original pierced hands, key and bell presented, it works perfectly without pendulum, and stops with a pendulum probably brought back Wear of use to the gilding, Height 43cm

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
