This exceptionally beautiful LXVI Napoleon III style bureau has been fully restored by an experienced restorer, the bronze has been thoroughly cleaned and the wood color has been refreshed with a new leather marquetry top. This bureau is stamped behind one of the round bronze ornaments of the famous cabinetmaker Befort Jeune. This is a completely original copy. The dimensions of this bureau are, 1.37 m long 0.72 m wide Total blade height 0.77 m 0.52 m legroom. Mathieu Befort, known as Befort Jeune (1813-1880), was a prominent 19th-century French politician. Cabinetmaker from a renowned family of cabinetmakers. His father, Jean-Baptiste Befort, originally from Belgium, supplied furniture to the apartments of the Duke of Orléans. Mathieu took over the family business
