The work clearly recalls the aesthetics and themes of Edgar Degas (1834-1917), a master of Impressionism, famous for his depictions of dancers in natural and spontaneous attitudes. The sculpture is distinguished by its delicate modeling and anatomical fidelity, capturing with great sensitivity the balance and grace of the female body. The surface has a uniform dark patina, highlighting the textures and folds of the garment. The work rests on a solid stone base with simple

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PASEO RECOLETOS 31 Madrid 28004 lines, which contrasts with the formal richness of the figure. The piece is signed on the base, although the signature is illegible, suggesting that it could be by a French sculptor of the early 20th century. The state of conservation is excellent, without defects or restorations, preserving the original patina. An ideal work for collectors of Impressionist sculptures or lovers of art related to classical dance.

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
