The top of the cabinet is majestically and symmetrically flanked by four sculptures representing Diana, goddess of the hunt, an emblematic figure in Roman mythology associated with nature, the moon and protection. These sculptures, carved with great realism and delicacy, present an exceptional sculptural quality, and on the back of one of them, the artist's mark or signature can be seen, which supports its authenticity and artistic value. The front of the sideboard features an exquisite relief carving with ornamental motifs inspired by
