### Description

Signed and dated on the back, this captivating painting by Luigi Pagan (active in the first half of the 20th century) depicts a lively scene of Chioggia, featuring an evocative view of the Calle d'Oro populated by local figures. The artist captures the atmosphere of the lagoon town through a dense and textured technique, marked by an expressive pointillism that in some ways recalls the work of his contemporary Gino Pavan. While it is not known whether they influenced one another, there is a clear stylistic affinity in their rendering of light and urban movement. The painting showcases a rich chromatic texture, with light and shadow playing across buildings and figures in a dynamic and detailed composition. The façades of the houses, rendered with a palette knife and impasto brushstrokes, create a vibrant
