- Pair of "officer's" spurs - Forged and engraved silver - By Laurent Voysin, master goldsmith in Marseille, dates (?) - Marseille, 1809-1819 - Length (loop to the wheel): 16 cm; width: 9.5 cm; weight: 188 g (95g & 93g) - Very good condition, beautiful and fresh engraving - Pair of silver spurs - perhaps officer's - in silver, with engraving of palmettes and in frames of fillets a decoration of interlacing "peacock feathers" - Hallmarks (on the branches): master goldsmith: L, an insect (a bee?), V, Laurent Voysin, master goldsmith in Marseille [Jourdan-Barry, K 168, p.245]; Title: in an oval, a rooster raising the dough and the number 1 at the top left, for the 1st title of 950 thousandths, Province from September 1, 1809 to August 16, 1819 [Helft,]; guarantee: Man's head in profile to the right,
