Interesting Saint Lô wardrobe called "wedding" with 2 doors and 3 shelves with drawers inside 19th century period The lower plinth is carved with a bouquet of flowers in the center and foliage scrolls on the sides The bottom of the doors has 1 large molded panel and is carved with flowers and leaves The top of the doors is carved with acanthus leaves and a bouquet of flowers in a basket The upper plinth is also carved with a basket of flowers with foliage scrolls The cornice is carved with oves and rudenté fillets The interior consists of 3 shelves including 1 with drawers This wardrobe is made of solid oak, including the dados and shelves The doors are supported by 3 solid brass hinges The 2 large central brass pins end with dolphins Original lock and key Fully pegged furniture that can be
